

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how we use and protect information provided when using this website or otherwise accessing any of our services. The site is owned and operated by Healthy Performance Ltd, who are committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website or otherwise accessing our services, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement, which was updated in September 2020.

What information do we collect?

We may collect some, or all the following information from you when you use our website and online platforms:

- Your Name, Age and Company Name
- Your department or location of work (for aggregated data only)
- Contact information including email address and telephone number
- Online wellbeing service responses

If you are validating a digital flu voucher, we will only collect from you your email address (which will be your work email address unless we permit otherwise from time to time at our absolute discretion) and your postcode/geographical location in order to suggest participating pharmacies in your area. We will only collect information as to whether or not you have validated and/or used your flu voucher (see the PharmOutcomes® paragraph in the 'Controlling your personal information section below') in order to report your validation/usage to your employer.

What we do with the information we gather?

We require information to understand your needs and provide a better service.

Internal record keeping

We may use the information to improve our products and services. We may also produce anonymised health reports to highlight health trends however these reports will be aggregated with no personal details shared with anyone, at any time.

We will only retain your personal data for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, regulatory, tax, accounting or reporting requirements. We may retain your personal data for a longer period in the event of a complaint or if we reasonably believe there is a prospect of litigation in respect to our relationship with you.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. To prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

How we use cookies

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website. Once you agree, the file is added, and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about webpage traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

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Links to other websites

Our website may contain links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over that other website. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. Your Rights

You have the following rights:

- to access any personal data that we hold about you
- to have inaccurate personal data rectified, or completed if it is incomplete
- to request to have personal data erased
- to request the restriction or suppression of personal data
- to receive personal data you have provided in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to request that we transmit any such data directly to another data controller
- to complain to the Information Commissioner's Office

We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties at any time unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so.

We may share your personal data with third parties to whom we may choose to sell, transfer or merge parts of our business or our assets. Alternatively, we may seek to acquire other businesses or merge with them. If a change happens to our business, then the new owners may use your personal data in the same way as set out in this privacy policy.
